Methodology




- Survey of 1,000 San Francisco Bay Area registered voters
- Demographics including age, gender, and ethnicity, are representative of registered voters in the 9-County Bay Area
- Conducted March 10-16, 2021
- Random selection of voters invited by email and text with link to web survey
- The survey was available in English, Chinese, and Spanish
- Where applicable, tracking shown from previous surveys conducted in 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, and 2020

Please note that due to rounding, some percentages may not add up to exactly 100%.

Key Findings




- 40% of Bay Area voters polled report being vaccinated, and the vast majority of those not yet vaccinated are planning to get a vaccine when it's available to them.
- Intentions to get vaccinated against COVID-19 are widespread across demographic groups. Even among groups wherein resistance to the vaccines is higher than average (such as Republicans, those without a 4-year college degree, and those in the North Bay counties), most are planning to get vaccinated.
- Asked why they do not plan to get vaccinated, top reasons cited include the belief that it isn't necessary, and that they are healthy. Others mention the novelty of the vaccines and concerns about the vaccines' safety or side effects.
- Although those who are vaccine hesitant generally do not trust federal, state or local government entities for information about the vaccines, many would trust their own doctor or healthcare provider.






Vaccination Status by Subgroups






Vaccine Resistance

Why do you say you won't get the vaccine?














Vaccine Trust Ratings – President Biden






Vaccine Trust Ratings – State Government








Vaccine Trust Ratings – Local Entities








Vaccine Trust Ratings – Your Own Doctor








Vaccine Trust Ratings – Local Health Dept.




